## NON-TRADITIONAL ARBITRATION WAIVER AND RELEASE

This Waiver and Release is voluntarily and knowingly entered into by Jennifer Moment
("the Grievant") in regard to the presentation and arbitration of Grievance Number 3300010418-1155-016
The Grievant acknowledges that he/she is aware that OCSEA, AFSCME Local 11, AFL-
CIO and the ODAS Office of Collective Bargaining have entered into an Agreement pursuant to Article
25.10 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) between the State of Ohio and OCSEA, AFSCME
