
STIPULATED AWARD

The undersigned arbitrator, being duly selected by the parties, convened an arbitration hearing on June **27, 2005** at the offices of SEIU District 1199 at Columbus, Ohio regarding grievance number **28-07-20050506-0193-02-12**.

After considerable negotiations, the parties agreed to resolve the grievance in the manner described in *Appendix A* which is incorporated by reference into this stipulated award.

The agreement as recorded in *Appendix A* shall cease to have effect upon the termination of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Appendix A

AN AGREEMENT

1. Parole Officers shall complete the initial phase of DNA collection, as required per Substitute House Bill 525,
2. After the initial phase of the DNA collection process has been completed, the Division of Parole and Community Services will discontinue the substantial role of the Parole Officers in the collection process, except for those instances where the Adult Parole Authority provides probation supervision services and on a situational basis.
3. From this date forward, the State will give the Union reasonable notice before there is a change in the testing procedures or the transportation of forensic samples, so that the Union may raise the issue at a regular or special APC or demand to bargain where the law requires such.
